DATE & COMPETITION VENUE

The 2022 1st Caribbean Games 3x3 basketball competition will take place from Friday July 1st to Saturday July 2nd at the **Memorial ACTe** located in Pointe-à-Pitre, Guadeloupe.

The events announced for the 1st Caribbean Games 2022 are:

COMPETITION FORMAT

8 men's teams and 6 women's teams will participate in the 1st Caribbean Games 2022. The competition will include a preliminary round, a semi-final and a final.

PRELIMINARY:

The eight / six teams will be divided into two groups (A and B) with four / three teams each. In the preliminary round, the teams will be qualified as follows:

A. They will be qualified according to wins / losses, awarding 2 points for each game won and 1 point for each game lost (even if this loss is due to an insufficient number of players) and 0 point for a game lost because of withdrawal.

B. If there are two teams with the same score, the results of the matches between the two teams involved will be used to determine their qualification.

C. If two or more teams are tied, a second qualification will be determined and only the result of the match between tied teams will be considered.

D. If there is still a tie after the second qualification, then the average number of baskets scored will be used to determine their place and the results of the matches between the teams which are still tied will be considered.

E. If the teams are still tied, their ranking will be determined by the average number of points scored in all matches played by each team.

F. The point average will always be calculated by dividing the total points scored by a team and the total number of points scored against that team.

RANKING MATCH:

SEMI FINAL:

The teams qualifying first and second in each group will play as follows:

SEMI-FINAL 1: First place in Group A against Second place in Group B

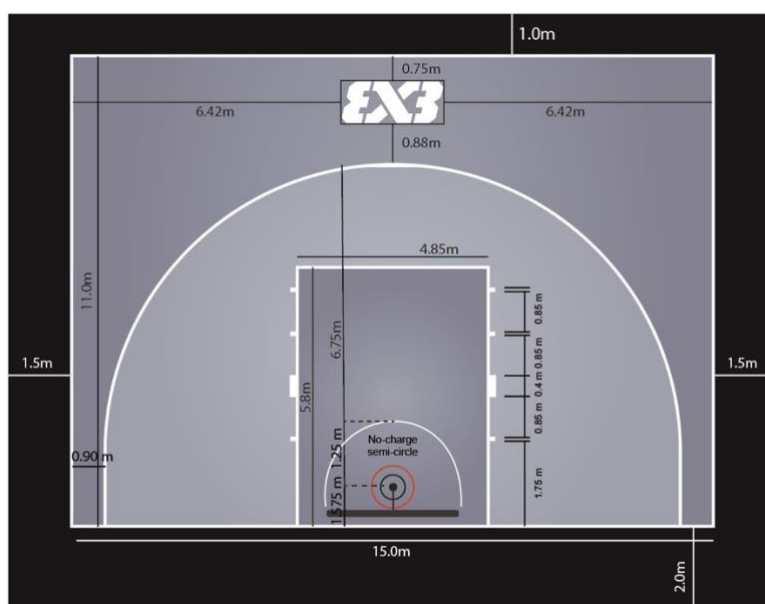
SEMI-FINAL 2: Second place of A against First place of Group B

FINAL

The winners of the semi-finals will compete for the gold medal and the losers will compete for the bronze medal.

COURT

The game will be played on a 3x3 basketball court with 1 basket. A regular 3x3 court playing surface is 15 m (width) x 11 m (length). The court shall have a regular basketball playing court sized zone, including a free throw line (5.80 m), a 2-point line (6.75 m) and a "no-charge semi-circle" area underneath the basket. Half of a traditional basketball court may be used.

DESCRIPTION :

- But de basket hauteur de 3m05 départ 2m25
- But transportable sur lequel est posé un lest de 640 kg.
- Protections des faces avant et latérales.

CONSIGNES D'UTILISATION :

- L'usage de ce but est exclu pour tout autre sport que le basket.
- Ne pas grimper sur la structure.
- Le but doit toujours être lesté avant toute utilisation. Le serrage des boulons doit être vérifié.
- En cas de non utilisation, le but doit être replié ou rendu inutilisable.

RECOMMANDATIONS D'UTILISATION :

- Lors du montage le but doit être manipulé par 3 personnes minimum.
- Le montage et l'entretien du produit doivent être réalisés suivant les instructions contenues dans cette notice.
- Les essais et modalités de contrôle des équipements sur site doivent être réalisés conformément à l'article R322-22 du code du sport.

ENTRETIEN : (Périodique)

- Un nettoyage régulier de l'ensemble du but permet de mieux visualiser les problèmes éventuels (fissure, déformation...).
- Vérifier l'état du panneau, du cercle et de la structure métallique (soudures). Resserrer les vis si nécessaire.

TEAM UNIFORMS

Teams must have at least one set of light and one dark uniforms

EMBLEMS OF THE NOC AND IDENTITY

The name and / or emblem / symbol of the country / territory / NOC must appear on the front of the jersey for the game according to the following:

- It can appear on the front of the shirt for the game and must occupy a maximum area of 20cm².
- For the name of the country, if the written text comprises a line, the letters must be a maximum of 8cm high. If the written text comprises two lines, the letters in each line must be a maximum of 6cm high.

ATHLETE NAME AND NUMBER

T-shirt for the game (Front)

- The athlete's number must appear and be clearly visible. It must have a minimum height of 10 cm and must be placed under the name or insignia of the country at a minimum distance of 5 cm from the player's number.

T-shirt for the game (Back)

- The player's first name (last name or preferred first name) must appear above the player's number and must comprise a single line of text. The letters must have a minimum height of 6cm and a maximum of 8cm.
- The player's number must appear and be clearly visible; It must have a minimum height of 20cm.

QUOTA

According to the quota established by CANOC, the 3x3 Basketball competitions will have a maximum of fifty-six **(56)** athletes of both sexes.

AGE OF ATHLETES

To participate in this U23 competition, athletes must be born between **Jan 01st 1999 and 31st December 2004.**

REGISTRATION

All countries, through the respective NOC, must send their Sports Registration applications in the official forms that the Organizing Committee will send in a timely manner no later than 00h.00 (Guadeloupe time) on **January 30, 2022.** The sports in which they will participate in the Caribbean Games "Guadeloupe 2022" must be indicated.

NUMERICAL REGISTRATION

All countries, through the respective Olympic Committee, must send their registration requests on the official forms which the Organizing Committee will send in due course.

The digital registration forms (indicating the number of participants in each: individual and team event) must be sent to the organizing committee of the 1st Caribbean Games Guadeloupe 2022 on or before the deadline date: before midnight (Guadeloupe time), **March 30, 2022**.

NOMINAL AND FINAL ENTRIES REGISTRATION

For each eligible athlete to participate in the 1st Caribbean Games Guadeloupe 2022, a nominative registration form must be completed.

These forms must be completed by the NOCs and sent to the organizing committee before midnight (Guadeloupe time) **May 30, 2022**.

Each NOC will have to send its digital entry and personal entry forms on the official forms provided by the organizing committee, which will be sent 6 months before the Games (Jan 2022). PARTICIPATION

Only the NOCs recognized by CANOC, whose national basketball federations are affiliated to the Caribbean Basketball Confederation (CBC) can register athletes in the basketball 3x3 competition of the 1st Caribbean Games, Guadeloupe 2022.

CANOC members / associate members not affiliated with CBC must be affiliated to a recognized regional association to participate.

EVENTS

There will be one women's competition and one men's competition, two **(2)** competitions altogether.

GUADELOUPE 2022 QUALIFICATION SYSTEM

Guadeloupe is automatically qualified as the host country for both competitions.

The Caribbean Basketball Confederation will use the official FIBA 3x3 ranking to determine the teams that will qualify for the 1st Caribbean Games 2022.

There are seven **(7)** places remaining for the men's competition and five **(5)** places remaining for the women's competition.

Qualified teams must confirm, through their national federations and their NOCs, in writing their participation before January 30, 2022.

If a team decides to withdraw from the Caribbean Games, the CBC will decide on the replacement team.

SPORTS EQUIPMENT

The official Ball for competition is the FIBA 3x3 ball produced by Wilson.

AWARDS

The prizes will be awarded in accordance with the regulations of Chapter XIX of CANOC:

- a) To the winning team a diploma and a gold medal and a diploma to all players
- b) To the team ranked second a diploma and a silver medal and a diploma to all players
- c) To the team ranked third a diploma and a bronze medal and a diploma to all players
- d) From fourth to eighth place, a diploma for each athlete

ANTIDOPING

The Caribbean Games Anti-Doping regulations are prepared by the CANOC Medical and Anti-Doping Commission in conjunction with the Caribbean RADO and reviewed by WADA.

ON-SITE SUPPORT

The Organizing Committee will bear the onsite logistic costs (accommodation, transportation, and meals) of the delegations from **June 27 to July 4, 2022**.

Please contact us if you would like an earlier arrival /late departure so that we can provide assistance for your extra stay if necessary. Note that all additional costs before and after the dates that will fall under the responsibility of the CG 2022 are the full responsibility of your delegation.

PARTICIPATION AND REGISTRATION FEES

1. Delegation Registration Fee by Sport

Each NOC must pay LOC, twenty-five US Dollars **(25.00 USD)** per sport in which it shall participate in respect of rights of registration for the Games.

2. Registration Fee per Participant

Each NOC and Associate Member must pay LOC, five US Dollars **(5.00 USD)** per participant registered for the Games.

3. Fee for Accommodation and Food

Each NOC and AM must pay fifteen US Dollars **(15.00 USD)** daily as a fee for Accommodation and Food for each participant that will reside in the Village per member of its delegation. The days of stay shall be counted from the moment that each member checks into the designated Village up to the day of check-out.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS TO GET IN GUADELOUPE*

Foreign citizens can travel to the French Overseas Territories depending on their vaccination status and the health situation of their country.

To date, the classification of the country is as follows:

- **"Green"** countries / territories: countries / territories in which no active circulation of the virus is observed, and no variants of concern have been identified. These are the countries of the European area, to which are added Saudi Arabia, Australia, Bahrain, Brunei, Canada, Chile, the Comoros, South Korea, Hong Kong, Japan, Jordan, Lebanon, New Zealand, Singapore, Taiwan, Ukraine, Uruguay, and Vanuatu.
- **"Orange"** countries / territories: countries / territories in which active circulation of the virus is observed in controlled proportions. These are all countries / territories that are not included in the lists of "green" and "red" countries / territories.
- **"Red"** countries / territories: countries / territories in which active circulation of the virus is observed with the presence of variants of concern. These are the following countries / territories: Afghanistan, South Africa, Algeria, Argentina, Bangladesh, Brazil, Colombia, Costa Rica, Cuba, Georgia, Indonesia, Iran, Maldives, Morocco, Mozambique, Namibia, Nepal, Pakistan, Democratic Republic of Congo, Russia, Seychelles, Suriname, Tunisia, and Turkey.

The control rules that are applied to travelers derive from common law and depend on the categorization of the country:

Ø for "**green**" countries, a negative **PCR test of less than 72 hours** or a **negative antigen test of less than 48 hours** is required for all passengers. In addition, IF you are NOT FULLY VACCINATED, you will also need a **7-day prophylactic isolation commitment**.

Ø for "**orange**" countries, a negative **PCR test of less than 72 hours** or a **negative antigen test of less than 48 hours** is required for all passengers. In addition, IF you are NOT FULLY VACCINATED, you will also need a **compelling reason, duly justified** according to a pre-established list, and a **7-day prophylactic isolation commitment**.

Ø for the "**red**" countries with high circulation of the virus, no resumption of traffic. The resumption of international air and sea links is linked to the commitment of companies (air and sea) to carry out checks on compliance with the conditions to be met by passengers before their departure.
